<b>TONIGHT</b>	Mostly clear this evening...Then becoming partly cloudy. Brisk with lows in the lower 20s. Northwest winds 15 to 20 mph... Diminishing to 5 to 10 mph after midnight.
<b>SATURDAY</b>	Cloudy. Snow likely in the afternoon. Snow accumulation up to 1 inch. Highs around 30. Northwest winds around 5 mph... Becoming northeast in the afternoon. Chance of snow 70 percent.
<b>SATURDAY NIGHT</b>	Snow...Mixing with sleet and possibly freezing rain after midnight. Areas near the south shore May change over to all sleet for a period of time overnight. Total snow accumulation of 3 to 8 inches. Brisk with lows in the mid 20s. Northeast winds 15 to 20 mph. Chance of precipitation near 100 percent.
<b>SUNDAY</b>	Cloudy with a chance of snow and sleet in the morning... Then partly sunny in the afternoon. Highs in the lower 30s. North winds 10 to 15 mph with gusts up to 25 mph. Chance of precipitation 50 percent.
<b>SUNDAY NIGHT</b>	Partly cloudy. Lows around 18. Northwest winds 5 to 10 mph.
<b>MONDAY</b>	Mostly sunny. Highs in the upper 20s.
